

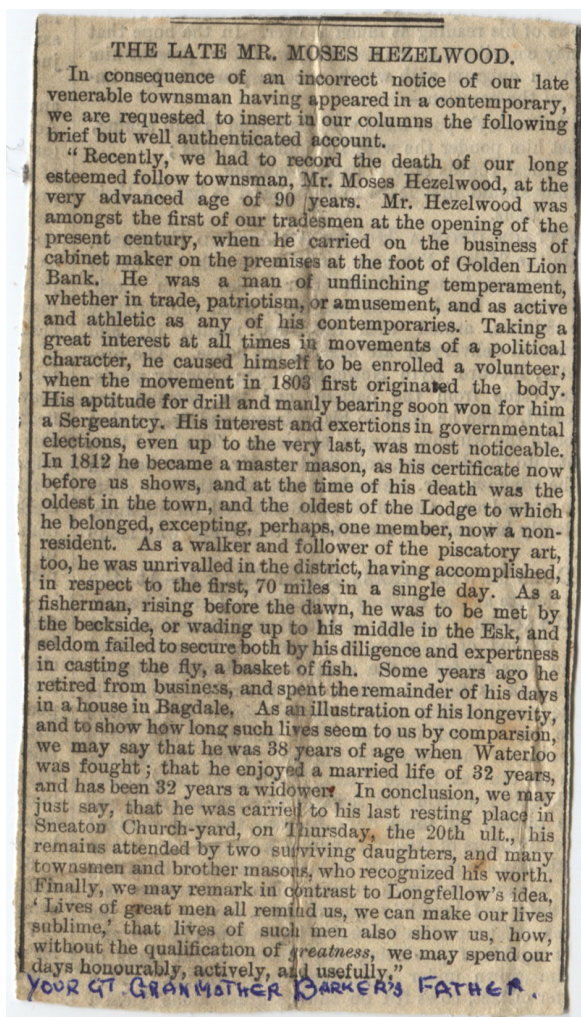

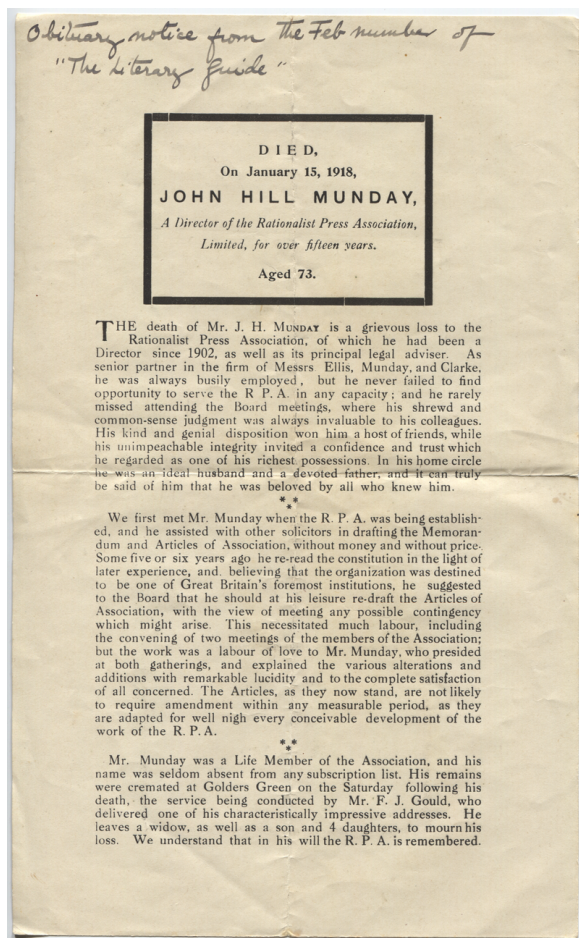

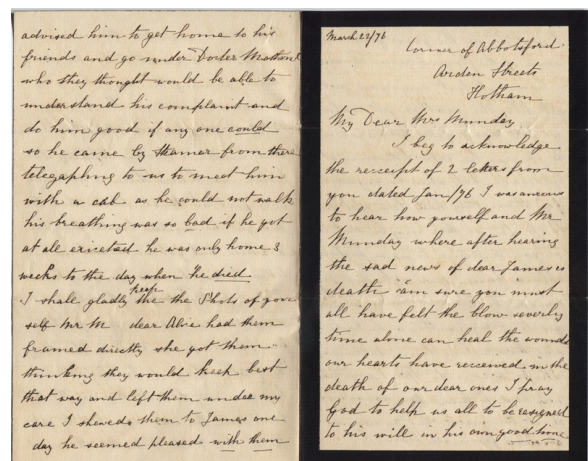
1: Item 1, Newspaper clipping from the **Whitby Gazette** re Moses Hezelwood, 1868

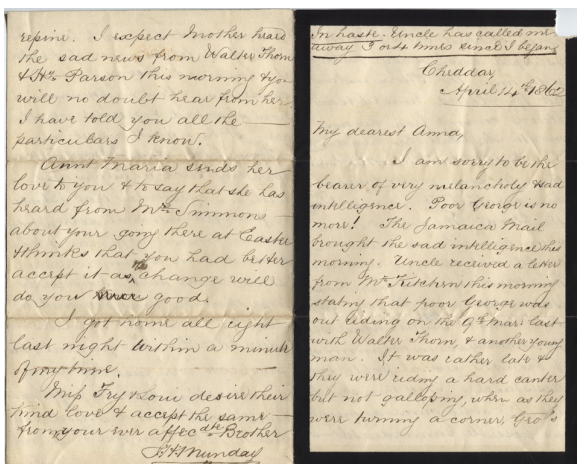

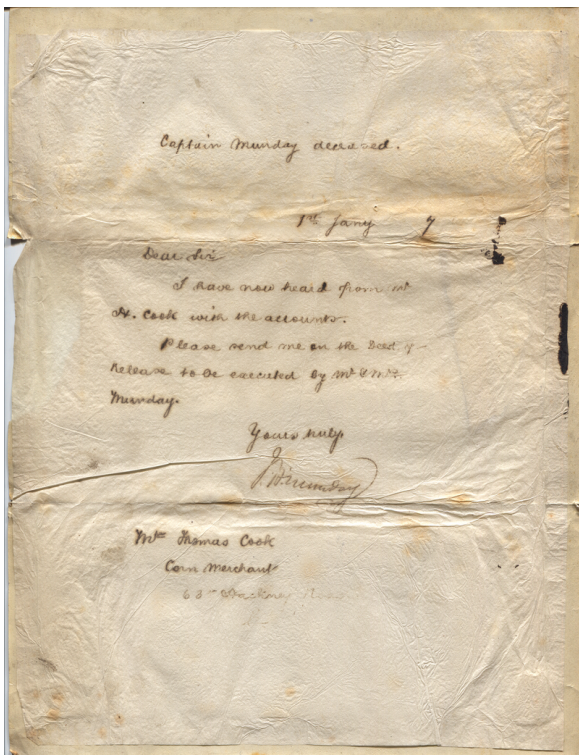

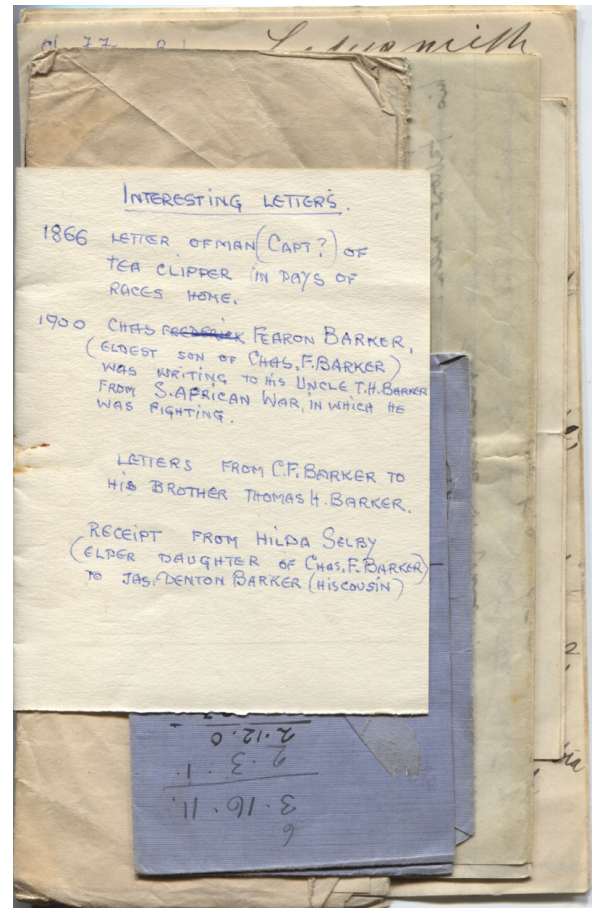


14: Item 18, Hill family crest, wax on paper
